Two Night Adventures; Paddle and Peddle

What could be better than staying on the beach? Biking and kayaking while also enjoying the beach. Nantucket has excellent bike paths and is fairly flat, making it easy to bike everywhere. Drop your things off at HI-Nantucket and let Easy Riders deliver your bikes. Peddle into Nantucket Village where you will find your kayaks waiting. Paddle through the calm protected waters of Nantucket Harbor, and explore 7 miles of deserted beach by kayak. At night, enjoy an excellent BBQ and exchange tales from the day over a fire and s'mores.

Three Nights

Learn about Nantucket's wildlife and edible plants; explore the UMASS Boston Field Station with an environmental educator on a guided 90 minute walk. Afterward, visit the Nantucket Shipwreck and Lifesaving Museum; learn about the network of lifesaving stations that once covered the East Coast. HI-Nantucket was once a lifesaving station; learn more about the historic accommodation.
