Two Night Adventure

Join the Mass Audubon at Felix Neck for a 2-hour guided kayak trip on Sengekontacket salt pond, ask about moonrise trips! After kayaking enjoy free time, head to South Beach or jump off the bridge featured in the movie *Jaws* by State Beach.

In addition to your kayaking adventure, head to Edgartown and catch the “On Time Ferry” to Chappaquiddick where a Trustees of Reservations naturalist will be waiting to pick you up. Join your guide identifying wildlife and conquering the dunes in the back of a comfortably outfitted four wheel drive pick up truck. End your journey at the Chappy lighthouse and learn about the keepers who watched over the sea for hundreds of years. Be sure to stop and explore the Japanese gardens on your way back. At night relax at HI-Martha's Vineyard, play a game of volleyball, and meet travelers from around the world.
